Tutors will aim to cover both technical problems and interpretative points which will be of interest to the entire class. Participants will each receive three half-hour slots during the week in class.

1. The course fee deposit of £180 for Masterclass Participants or Observers is non-refundable, whether 'rolled over' towards the 2021 course or used towards the current 2020 course. If a place cannot be offered due to the course being fully booked, fees will be refunded in full.
2. In the unlikely event of a course being cancelled, monies paid to the Summer School for Pianists in respect of course fees will be refunded, but participants are responsible for any other costs incurred.
3. The Summer School for Pianists reserves the right to provide a substitute tutor if the advertised tutor has to withdraw, owing to unforeseen circumstances.
4. By completing and returning this form, you agree to The Summer School for Pianists processing the personal data contained in the form in order to organise, administer and host the course. Under no circumstances will The Summer School for Pianists sell the information provided in this form to third parties. A copy of our privacy policy can be found on our website. 5. Masterclasses will be held using 'Zoom'. Participants and Observers should ensure that they are comfortable using 'Zoom'. Participants should also ensure that they have a workable setup for piano playing via 'Zoom'. If you would prefer to make an audio or video recording that can be sent to tutors, please let your tutor know well in advance and ensure you have familiarised yourself with how to make and send the recording.
6. Your place will be confirmed following receipt of your application, subject to payment. In the event that the course becomes oversubscribed, the Summer School for Pianists reserves the right to decline applications, in which case a full refund of any course fees paid will be provided. Places on the course are non-assignable, except by consent of the Summer School for Pianists.
7. If you wish to cancel your place on the course please inform the Summer School for Pianists as soon as possible by email or by post. Cancellation charges apply, such that refunds will be provided on the following basis:
 - a. For cancellations notified by a Masterclass Participants no later than 1st July 2020, a refund equivalent to 50% of the course fee balance of £70, i.e. £35, will be available. This applies both to Participants who paid an initial deposit and to those who paid the course fee in one go. No refund of the deposit of £180 will be available.
 - b. No refunds are available for cancellations notified after 1st July 2020.
 - c. The course fee for Observers is non-refundable.
